Situation assessment

Our active members are Anti Poaching experts, Instructors, and Conservation Scientists.

Therefore the Organisation can:

Grasp the various problems caused by poaching and propose Anti Poaching solutions suitable to the socio-economical situation proper to the protected National Park, Wildlife Reserve or community hunting concessions etc.

Conduct studies and audits on the needs for instructing staff or personnel from Wildlife and Conservation Ministries. Identify needs in terms of manpower and equipment, and set up budgets for Anti Poaching on short or long term basis.

Intervene as technical support on the ground for protection personnel already in place.

Ensure paramilitary instruction for governmental staff and state agents essential for their function. Ensure specific instruction: eco-tourism, first aid, radio operator, aviat microlight pilot ...

Propose, set up and follow scientific protocols on the running and the impact of the Anti Poaching policy conducted.

The organization is composed of active and beneficiary members.

Active members take part actively in the missions of the organisation. They carry out instruction and control missions on the ground. These members have already carried out Anti poaching missions in many countries. Some are sworn agents and other have the title of Chief Warden.
